C.1. Contract with Risk Management Solutions (RMS) for Claims Administration and Litigation Management

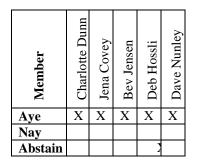
Michael Simmons summarized his review of the contract language in the current ACCEL contract with Carl Warren, and walked through the proposed changes to the contact to be implemented with RMS. Deb clarified that the Committee previously focused on the scope of work, but did not work on the contract itself. Conor reported that Carl Warren had provided a contract template that may be where the issues stem from.

After some discussion the Committee suggested deleting sections 1 (General), 2 (Investigative Services), 3 (Settlement Authority), 4 (Claims Adjustment Services), 5 (Administrative Services), 6 (Legal Support Services). The Committee further reviewed the proposed contract, making additional edits throughout. The Committee revised the Hold Harmless Agreement and Settlement Authority.

A motion was made to recommend the contract with RMS to the ACCEL Board.

Item No. C.1 Claims Committee June 16, 2016

LIABILITY CLAIMS ADMINISTRATOR REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

ISSUE: At the April Board Meeting, the Board gave direction to the administrators to work with Risk Management Services (RMS) to work on a short term contract from June 1 to November 28, 2016. During that time, ACCEL would issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to begin services December 1, 2016 with the selected firm.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Claims Committee review and take action to recommend to the Board of Directors. Action may be taken or direction given.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact expected from the issuance of the RFP.

ACCEL's contract with Carl Warren was a negotiated flat fee of \$82,000. ACCEL is currently working with RMS, who agreed to a 6 month contract for \$41,000 plus additional expenses for data migration and travel (\$7,000). ACCEL's FY 16/17 budget is estimated to be \$100,000 for TPA services during FY16/17 which will be paid in part to RMS, and in part to the selected firm.

BACKGROUND: ACCEL has worked with Carl Warren and Company for over 20 years. ACCEL is currently working with RMS on a short term basis until the RFP process is completed. Within the RFP, a timeline has been proposed as follows:

The Claims Committee will work with the Program Administrators prior to the RFP issue date to both improve this Draft document as well as fine tune the draft Agreement to include with the RFP.

Item No. C.2 Claims Committee June 16, 2016

CLAIMS ADMINISTRATION CONTRACT WITH RMS

ISSUE: After the Claims Committee review the Contract was reviewed by RMS. They requested to changes (that have been made in this proposed Agreement):

- 1. Liability Insurance Limits reduced to \$2,000,000 for all coverages
- 2. Remove the requirement for maintaining Closed Session Minutes¹

RECOMMENDATION: The Claims Committee recommends the Board review and approve the proposed contract with Risk Management Solutions (RMS) with small amendments since last review. Action may be taken or direction given.

FISCAL IMPACT: Approximately \$50,000. The Fee will be \$41,000, plus data transition expenses and requested travel expenses.

BACKGROUND: Effective June 1st ACCEL has transferred control of claims to Risk Management Services (RMS). Carl Warren & Company (CWC) is under contract until June 30th but to be sure of a smooth transition, claims files were transferred prior to June 1st.

The RMS Agreement will be for six (6) months, expiring November 28, 2016. During this period the Claims Committee and Board will issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) and conduct interviews for a 3+ year contract to be in effect prior to December 1st.

The Claims Committee should review the draft Agreement and provide a recommendation to the Board for approval by the Board at their upcoming meeting on June 16th. **This Agreement will be retroactive to June 1, 2016.**
